The Centre for European Research in Microfinance (CERMi) is a multilingual, international research centre based in Belgium ([www.cermi.eu](http://www.cermi.eu)). Thanks to the sponsorship of the National Bank of Belgium, CERMi is offering a full time one year research fellowship on microfinance, at the Solvay Brussels School of Economics and Management (SBS-EM), ULB.

Created in 2007, CERMi draws together European researchers in microfinance. Currently, it gathers 11 doctoral students and 3 post-doctoral students working on microfinance and a wide international network of more than 30 research associates.
